**Examples:**

**Adopt-A-Grandparent Program Leader at Odd-Fellows Senior Living** April 2021 - Present  
Whitman College, Walla Walla, WA

- Navigated the program's transition to remote by adapting to scheduling changes and communicating with both volunteers and program coordinators, resulting in 15 online engagement events with average attendance of 25
- Communicated and cooperated with 7 fellow program leaders to plan 10 joint community events, facilitating inter-community connections with 85 students from different programs
- Held orientation for over 30 new volunteers, including registration process set-up for volunteer roles with Odd-Fellows to successfully pair them with seniors and activities they were interested in

**Student Leader for K-12 Educational Partnerships** August 2021 - May 2022  
Whitman College, Walla Walla, WA

- Facilitated weekly meetings with 4 student program leaders to support them in volunteer coordination, event planning and navigating partnerships with local schools.
- Acted as liaison between school leadership and program leaders to communicate tasks and progress, ensuring on-time completion of projects and high-quality programs.
- Planned and executed a Holiday gift drive and gift-wrapping event, supporting 25 local families through food, clothing and gift-card donations.

**Mentor Program Volunteer**, Whitman College, Walla Walla, WA Jan. 2020 - Present

- Interacted weekly with a first-grade boy at risk for Adverse Childhood Experience (ACEs) to provide social-emotional support and build trust
- Used motivational interviewing and active listening skills and acted as a role model to increase likelihood for future educational, emotional, and career success
- Provided detailed written and verbal updates to the case social worker on a weekly basis to ensure continuity of care
