Examples:

Senator, Associated Students of Whitman College, Walla Walla, WA Aug 2016 - May 2018

- Represented fellow peers as a member of the Student Affairs Committee by collaboratively writing and voting on legislation
- Vetted ASWC funding requests for student engagement events hosted by on-campus clubs and groups to ensure regulatory compliance and high-quality programs
- Advocated for change on campus through student interaction and open communication with faculty and administration

- Trained over 30 new ASWC representatives on proper bylaw interpretation through in-person sessions and written guides, ensuring understanding of procedure and effective operation of student government
- Facilitated conflict management through investigation and impeachment proceedings, communicating with multiple parties simultaneously to reach the best solutions for student leaders and organizations
- Collaborated with 3 committee members on election planning and advertisements, increasing Spring 2022 election voter turn-out for ASWC student officials by 100%

- Collaborated with the Mental Health Awareness Club to build community and promote 10 intersectional events to raise awareness for the connections between mental health and climate change, reaching a combined audience of 200 students.
