**Examples:**

**German Tutor**, Whitman College, Walla Walla, WA September 2019 - Present

- Tutored over 30 students in beginning to intermediate German language classes using a variety of teaching skills to foster understanding of class content and language comprehension
- Assigned additional readings and writing activities to students in their areas of difficulty, and hosted weekly conversation classes which resulted in improved grades and comprehension of the material
- Collaborated with several professors on tutoring assignments to ensure proper understanding of topic area, appropriate use of practice tests for mentees and accurate explanation of class content during tutoring sessions

**Computer Science Mentor**, Whitman College, Walla Walla, WA January - December 2020

- Assisted professor in an intro-level CS course focusing on program design and problem-solving using Python by offering tailored advice to students based on their learning styles and content knowledge
- Held weekly office hours for 40 students to review key topics and assignments, assist with test preparation and provide study tips resulting in improved student academic performance
- Adapted to an online system of mentoring over Google Meet, Zoom, and phone; utilized the screen sharing feature to assist students with editing their code
