% of Students from Washington



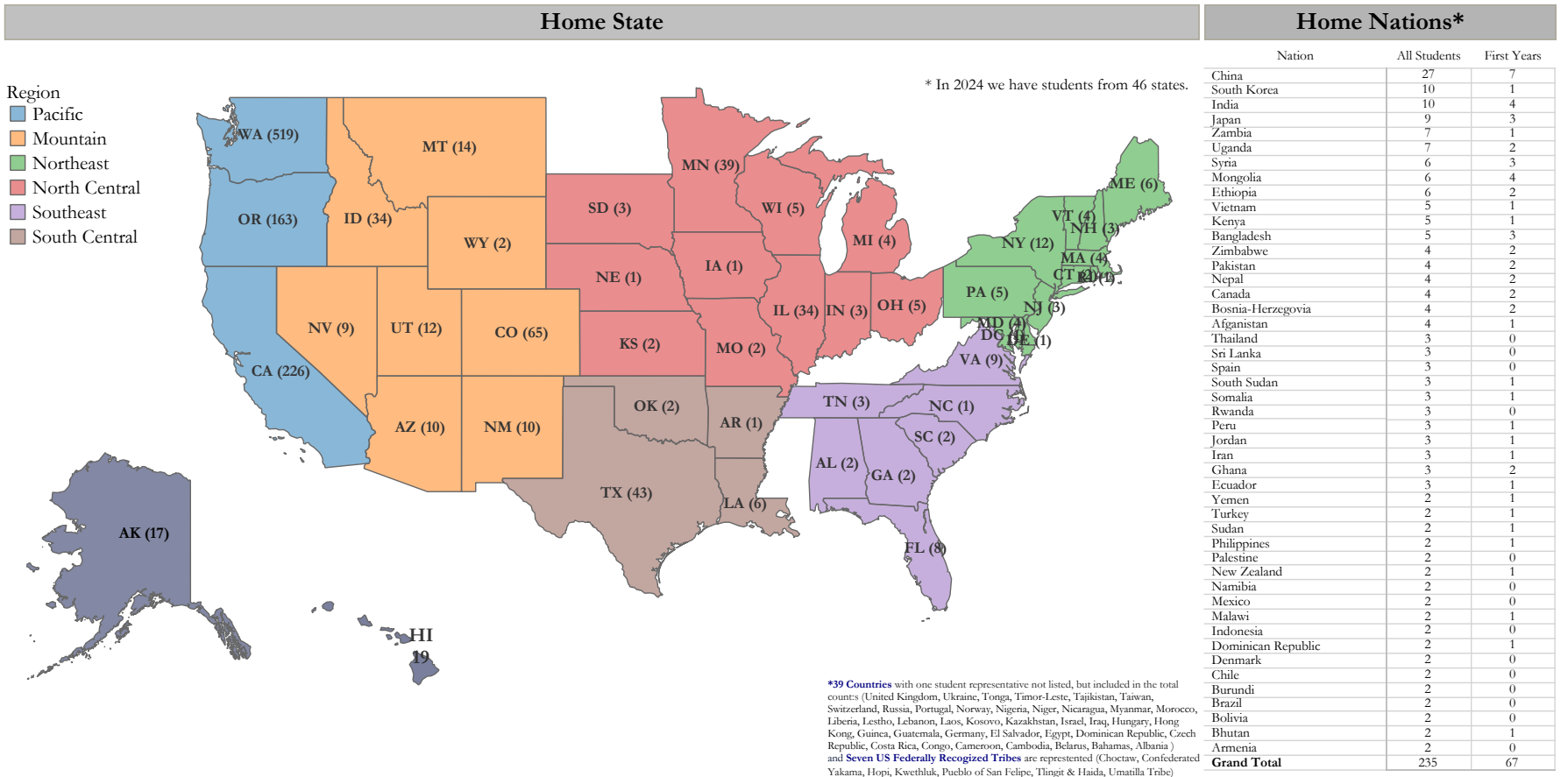
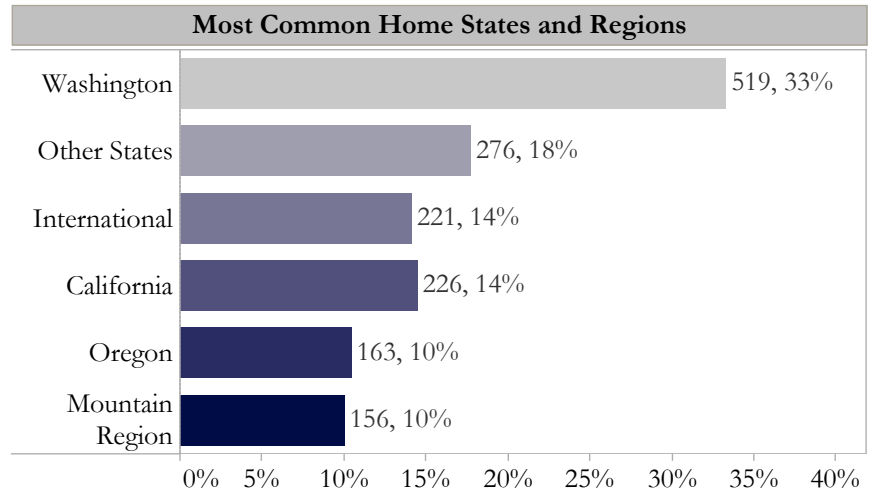

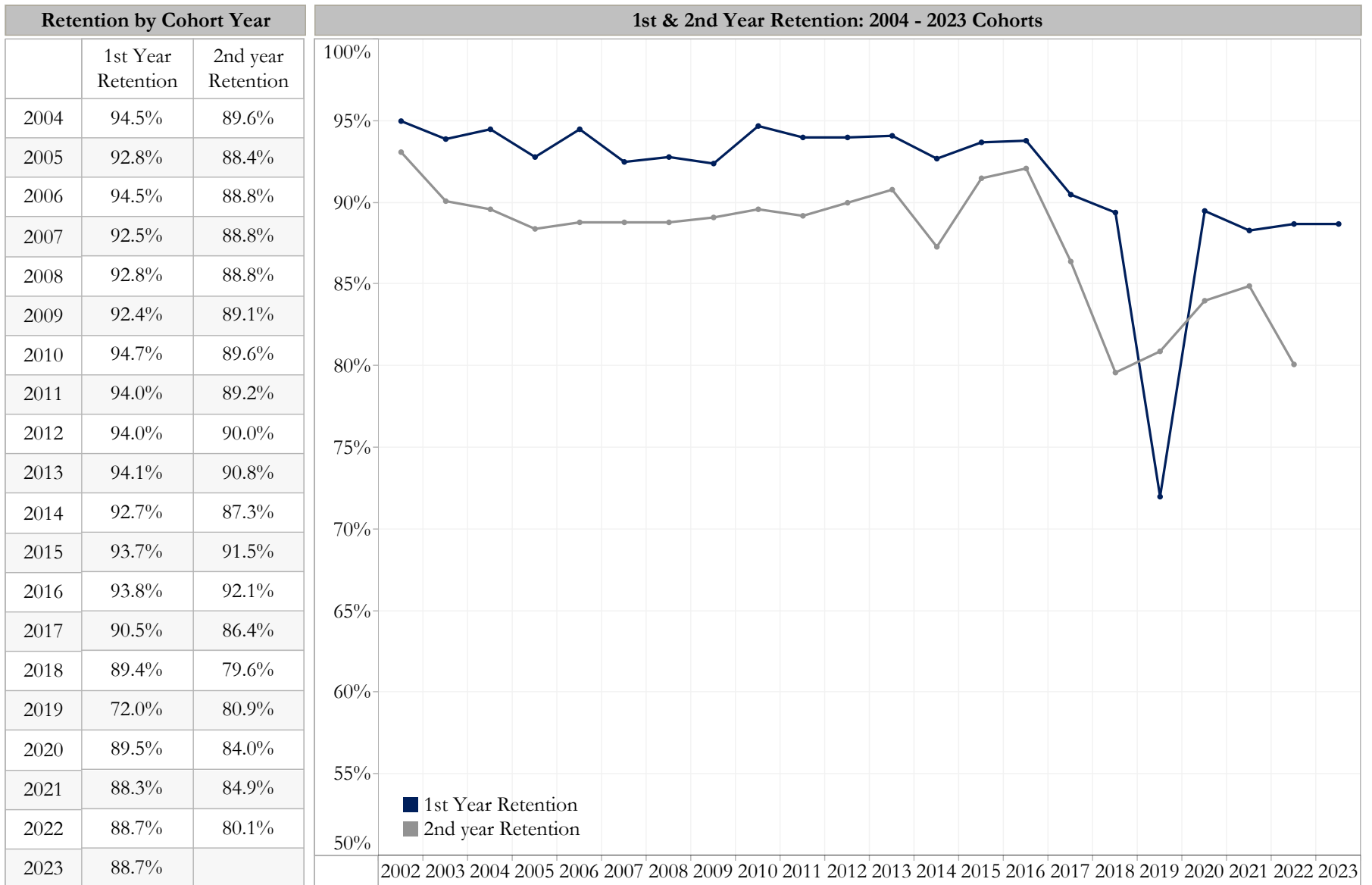

First and Second Year Retention Rates

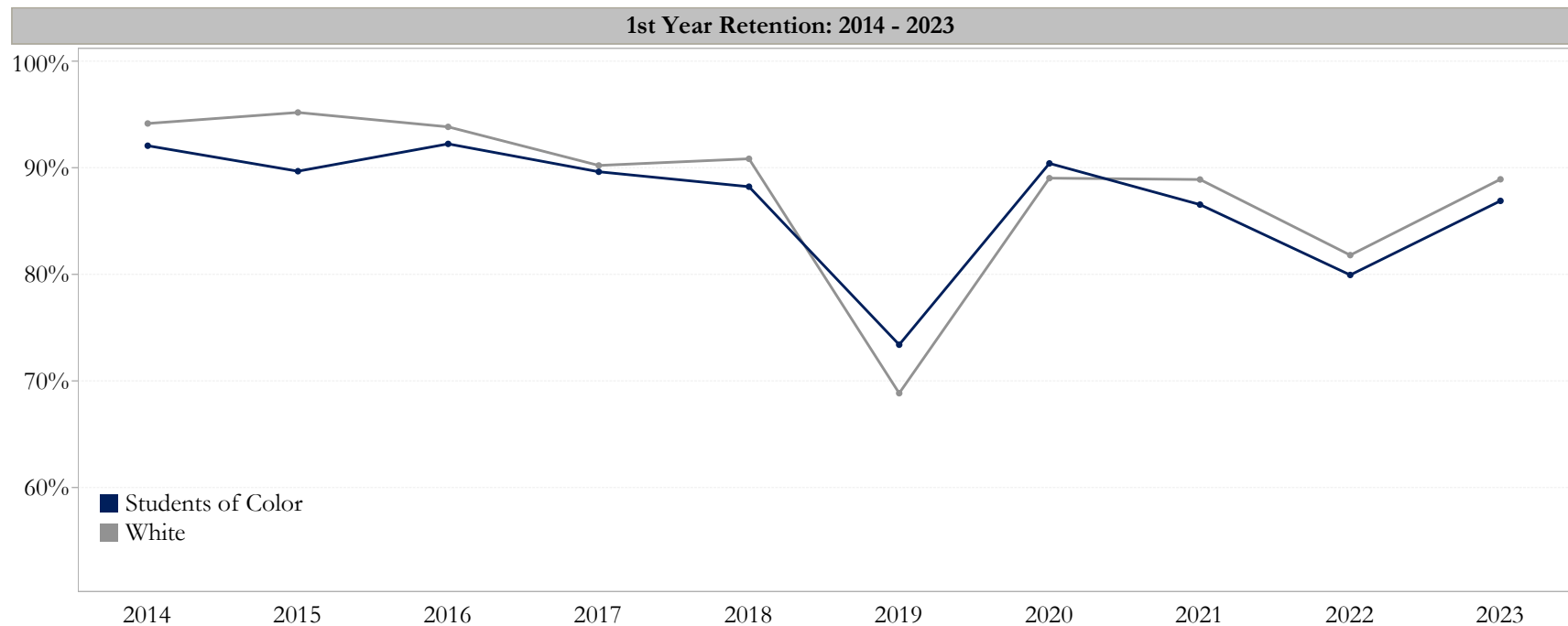

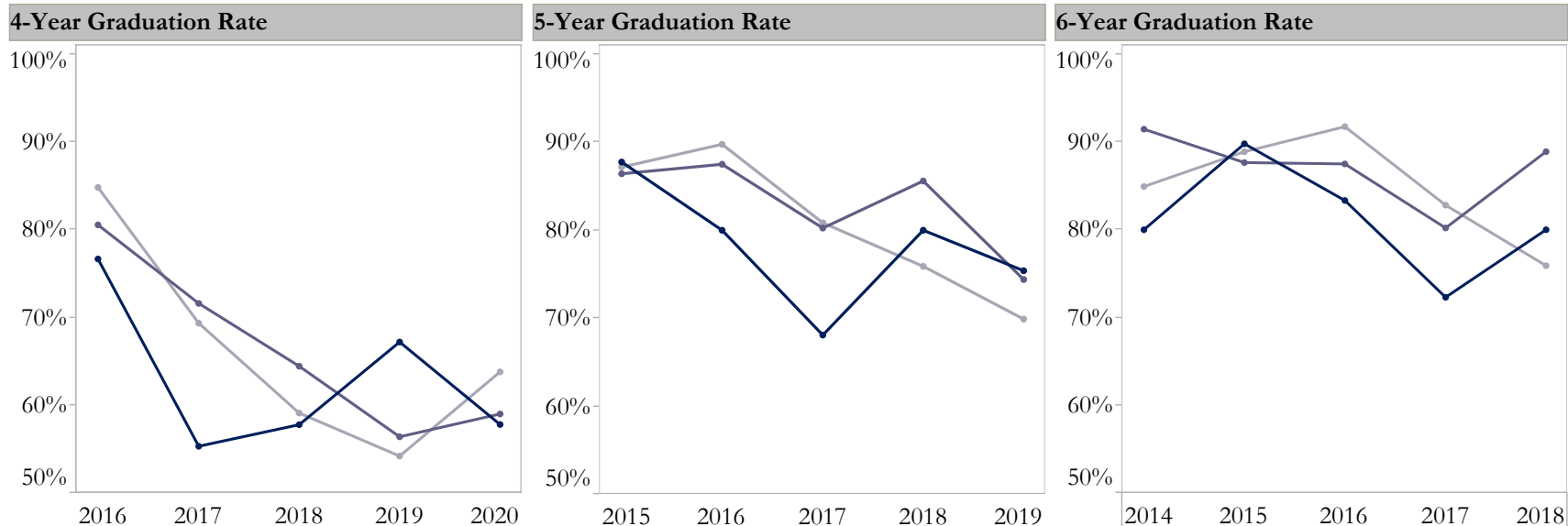

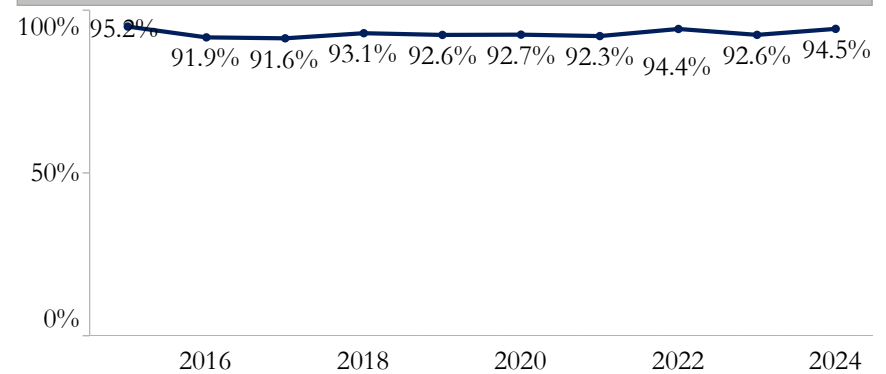
