Distribution Requirements fill in as the student takes courses. Once a requirement is complete, other courses that could count there fill in under "Other Credit" at the end of the Evaluation.

Major Requirements only appear on the Academic Evaluation after a student declares their major. The **major GPA** appears in this area.

***IP** means a course is currently in progress (see key at end of Eval).

The Senior Assessment shows up as a course and is filled in after the Registrar's Office receives confirmation from the major department that the student has passed. Students don't register for this like a true class.

Current completed credits and GPA—this is the student's cumulative GPA.

Remaining requirements (not including current courses or preregistered credits). The Institutional Credits line is 0.00 because this student has already completed more than 54 credits at Whitman.

Any remaining credits required after completion of "anticipated" credits.

All credits in progress (current enrollment + any preregistered credits). So, between preregistration (in November or April) and the end of a semester (in December or May), it shows two terms' worth of credits.

***NE** means a Non-course Equivalency—this indicates AP or IB credit, or, if it's a zero-credit course equivalency, like this one, a placement test (see key at end of Eval).

Since this *NE example has a credit value listed, it's either AP or IB credit. Usually, AP appears with the term date of 06/30, whereas IB has a date of 07/01.

*TE indicates transfer coursework (see key at end of Eval).

This area gives a **key for symbols** that may appear next to courses—other common notations include :
*RP for a course being repeated
*RA for a replacement attempt (repeating a course with a previous grade of F)
*F for "forced"—the course was manually inserted into a requirement by a staff member in the Registrar's Office

Completed Activity Credit Totals and Applied Music Credits show the number of credits completed in each area and the maximum allowed—these do not show credits in progress. Credits beyond the limits will not count toward degree requirements.
