We're In: The White House COVID-19 College Vaccine Challenge



As part of our commitment to helping bring the COVID-19 pandemic to an end, we are pleased to share that Whitman has joined the White House COVID-19 College Vaccine Challenge.

Participating colleges and universities make three key commitments:

- 1. Make sure every member of our campus community knows they are eligible for the vaccine and has the resources to find one.
- 2. Lead the way by identifying champions for vaccine efforts across campus and implementing a plan to get as many members of your college community vaccinated as soon as possible.
- 3. Meet your community where it is: Bring vaccines on-site, and make it easy for students, staff, and faculty to get vaccinated at sites nearby them this summer.

With 69% of our current employees and students vaccinated, we've still got a ways to go before we reach our goal of a fully vaccinated campus. Over the summer, we'll continue to share information on where to get vaccinated and how to report your completed vaccination process.

Travel and Quarantine

Employees and students who are vaccinated may travel within the U.S. without quarantining upon return to campus. Anyone who has not provided proof of vaccination must quarantine for ten days before returning to campus.
