Q: How do we know if we will have access to campus this summer?

A: If you are a faculty or staff member, you will automatically have access to campus this summer regardless of vaccine status. If you are a student, you must provide proof of being fully vaccinated and complete the online form to request summer access.

If you are vaccinated and approved for campus access, you will receive an email by the end of the week with your campus access badge for the summer.

If you are an employee who has not provided proof of being vaccinated, you will receive an email with information on when to take your required weekly COVID test in order to receive your weekly campus access badge.
